The Apple Pie Eating Contest, held at 3 p.m. both Saturday and Sunday, provides lots of laughs and prizes for winners. Competitions are held in these age categories -- 10 and under, 11-14 and 15 and up. Contestants are chosen by lottery and must sign up from 10 a.m.-2: 45 p.m. at the Hospitality Booth on the Main Green.

Some of the exciting performers in the weekend schedule of live entertainment include the Give 'n Take Jugglers, Diablo Sandwich, and Mike Brill on Saturday and Nassau Brass, Tucker's Tales Puppet Theater, and Christy Jefferson on Sunday.
