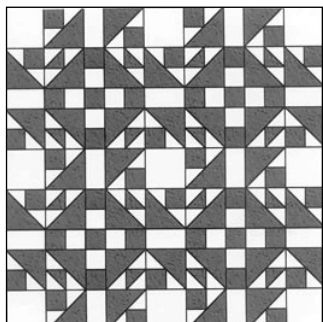

Official Competition Rules & Regulations

1. Entry Forms: There is no fee to enter. The Deadline for completed entry forms is **January 1, 2010**. You may enter a maximum of one quilt per each category. You must fill out a separate entry form for each submission. A single quilt may not be entered in more than one category (i.e., a Traditional Amish quilt may not be entered in both the Traditional and Amish categories). Professional quilters making a living from the sale of their own quilts or from teaching are prohibited from entering. Please submit a separate piece of paper along with your entry form stating your **“Artist’s Statement”**. Include any details that you think may be of interest to the Judges (i.e., construction technique, inspiration, asking price - if for sale)

2. Entry Drop Off: Completed entries must be dropped off at the Peddler’s Village Hospitality Center located in the lobby of the Cock ’n Bull Restaurant on **Sunday, January 3 between the hours of 10:00 am and 6:00 pm**.

3. Entry Display: Entries must remain on display in Peddler’s Village Gazebo from **January 11 through April 10, 2010**. Peddler’s Village reserves the right not to exhibit all entries due to space limitations. The displaying of quilts will be at the discretion of Peddler’s Village Management.

4. Judging: Entries will be judged the week of **January 4, 2010**. Entries are judged on a scale of 1 to 5 based on:

1. *Aesthetic Value (i.e., Use of Color, Overall Visual Design)*
2. *Sewing Workmanship (i.e., Piecing & Appliqué)*
3. *Quilting (i.e., Choice of Design & Even Stitching)*
4. *Borders, Binding, Finish (i.e., Consistency of Detail)*

5. Winners: Prizes will be mailed **no later than February 1, 2010**. The winner’s list will not be available by phone. Entrants will receive a copy of the winner’s list by mail. Copies will be available in the Hospitality Center **January 11**.

6. Entry Specifics:

- Copy an established quilting pattern or technique, use an established quilt design for inspiration or create your own design to fit one

of the categories. *See individual categories for specific quilting requirements.*

- Quilts must have a 3” x 5” cloth tag sewn securely to the reverse side of the work which states: name, address, phone number, and category entered. The quilt must be signed and include its date of completion.

- Quilts must be prepared for hanging with a 1 and 1/2 inch piece of fabric running the width of the work that should be sewn securely to the reverse side 1/4 inch from the top (DO NOT FORM A POCKET LOOP). Note: Entries will be tacked up through this fabric piece. (Clothing need not be prepared in this manner.)

- **Size: Quilts may not exceed 48 x 48 inches maximum.**

- Peddler’s Village will maintain security with wooden barriers that provide a deterrent to the public from handling quilts and will insure each quilt against theft up to \$200.

- Each entry must be submitted in a cloth pillow case or bag with an identification tag stating: your name, phone number, and category entered. **ONE ENTRY PER PILLOW CASE or BAG PLEASE.**

7. Entry Pick Up: Entries can be picked up from **April 19 through April 26th**. You will receive a letter requesting you to arrange a pick-up day and approximate time. You will then receive a confirmation for your pick up date, and location. We reserve the right to retain any entries remaining after that date if alternate pick up arrangements have not been made in advance.

8. Quilts for Sale: You may choose to display your quilt as “available for purchase”. We will include a notation indicating the quilts that are for sale and your asking price on the entry list posted at the display. Guests interested in purchasing quilts can contact Peddler’s Village. We will pass their contact information along it to you. It is up to you to if you choose to complete the sale, however all quilts must remain on display the duration of the show even if they have been sold.

9. Photographs: Peddler’s Village reserves the right to photograph entries for promotional and/or advertising without compensation.
