Feeling Creative? Enter the Third Annual "PEEPS® in the Village" Competition and Display at Peddler's Village

"Last year, we had more than a hundred entries and welcomed 80,000 visitors who came to see the six-week show. We are always struck by the incredible creativity on display for this event, which is a terrific spring complement



to our long-established scarecrow display in the fall and our gingerbread display during the holidays. We're looking forward to seeing what PEEPS® themes emerge this year!"
