## Peddler's Village Presents American Road Trip-Themed Sand Sculpture Display, Summer Events

*Sights in Sand: An American Road Trip, which began on June 1, features sand sculptures celebrating iconic landmarks and historical moments in honor of America250.*

Lahaska, PA-- [Peddler's Village](#), a countryside shopping, dining, lodging, and family entertainment destination in the heart of historic Bucks County, PA, will be presenting several summer events, including the all-American-themed sand sculpture display, Sights in Sand, which began on June 1 and continues through August 31. Other major summer events include the Red, White & Blueberries BBQ Bash and Peach Festival.

[Sights in Sand: An American Road Trip](#) celebrates the iconic landmarks and destinations that define the American travel experience, taking guests on a coast-to-coast journey through the nation's five major regions: the Northeast, Southeast, Midwest, Southwest, and West. Sand sculptures include recognizable attractions such as Independence Hall, Statue of Liberty, Kennedy Space Center, Mount Rushmore, and the Golden Gate Bridge. Guests of all ages can also participate in a sand sculpture-themed scavenger hunt. In June, July, and August, guests can enter a free giveaway which includes a complimentary overnight stay at the on-property Golden Plough Inn, breakfast for two, a \$150 dining gift card, two passes to Mercer Museum, and two history books: *Hidden History of Bucks County* and *Historic Sites and Bites*, totaling approximately \$500. Also this summer, Peddler's Village will present a [murder mystery dinner](#) on June 19, and, in partnership with the Central Bucks Chamber of Commerce, the [Bucks Fever Art & Sculpture Exhibition](#) from June 19 through July 19 as well as [Tunes at Noon](#) on Fridays through August 28. On June 20 and 21, [Father's Day weekend](#), Earl's New American will debut a new brunch tapas menu, available from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays. Guests can also discover thoughtful Father's Day gifts at more than 60 unique [shops](#) throughout the Village.

On July 4 from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m., the [Red, White & Blueberries BBQ Bash](#) will include live music, old-fashioned games, and all-American grilled favorites. Santa and Mrs. Claus will be

vacationing at Peddler's Village on July 24 through 26 for [Santa's Summer Holiday](#). Special events include a Food Truck Friday and Breakfast with Santa at Buttonwood Grill (details coming soon).

On August 1 & 2, Peddler's Village will present its annual [Peach Festival](#) featuring peach-inspired food and drinks, live music, shop specials, activities, and, new for this year, fresh Georgia peaches from [The Peach Truck](#), the presenting sponsor of this year's festival. Attendees and locals can [pre-order peaches for pick-up](#) during the festival. On August 13 through 16, guests can purchase tickets for [Tony Braithwaite & Friends](#), a comedic dinner theater experience presented in partnership with the [Bucks County Center for the Performing Arts](#).

Beginning August 31 and continuing through October 20, the [Pet Photography Competition & Exhibit](#) will showcase dozens of pet photographs submitted by local amateur and professional photographers. In September, the annual autumn display, [Scarecrows in the Village](#), will return with more than 100 imaginative scarecrows on display throughout the Village through October 25. The entry forms for both competitions will open in early summer.
